

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

The Thermopolis Town Council met in regular session October 17, 2017 at 7 pm at Town Hall. Present were Mayor Mike Mortimore, Council members Tony Larson, John Dorman Sr. and Bill Malloy. Also, present were Mayor/Codes Administrative Assistant Fred Crosby, Clerk/Treasurer Tracey Van Heule, Police Chief Steven Shay, Public Works Director Ernie Slagle, Town Engineer Anthony Barnett and Town Attorney Mike Messenger. Council member Dusty Lewis was absent.

AGENDA: Following the pledge of allegiance, Malloy made a motion, seconded by Larson and carried to approve the agenda as written.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT: Malloy made a motion, seconded by Dorman and carried to approve the financial statement for September 2017.

CITIZEN PARTICIPATION: SHORTY'S: CATERING PERMIT: Larson made a motion, seconded by Malloy and carried to approve a catering permit for the Pheasants Forever Banquet at the Fairgrounds on October 28 from 5-11 pm.

CITIZEN PARTICIPATION: PEOPLE FOR PEOPLE: STREET CLOSURE: Judy Carswell asked for a revised street closure for the Downtown Holiday Event. Larson made a motion, seconded by Mortimore and carried to approve closing the north side of Broadway from 4th to 5th street on December 9 from noon to 9pm.

TOWN ENGINEER: ANTHONY BARNETT: Barnett noted the 12th street sewer line project is progressing and asphalt repair is scheduled for October 26. Additional discussion ensued on costs for water drainage on upper Fremont Street, water tank painting, the sewer lift station repair and state review of the water line project.

ADMINISTRATION: FRED CROSBY: Nothing at this time.
