

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

The Thermopolis Town Council met in regular session October 19, 2021, at 7 pm at Town Hall. Present were Mayor Mike Chimenti, Council members Tony Larson, John Dorman Sr., Bill Malloy and Dusty Lewis. Also, present were Mayor/Codes Administrative Assistant Fred Crosby, Clerk/Treasurer Tracey Van Heule, Public Works Director Ernie Slagle, Interim Police Chief Pat Cornwell, Town Engineers Anthony Barnett and Heath Overfield and Town Attorneys Mike Messenger and Marshall Keller.

AGENDA: Following the pledge of allegiance, Larson made a motion, seconded by Malloy and carried to approve the agenda as written.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT: Malloy made a motion, seconded by Dorman and carried to approve the financial statement for September 2021.

CITIZEN PARTICIPATION: GOLF COURSE MINUTES: Lewis made a motion, seconded by Dorman and carried to acknowledge the minutes.

ENGINEER: ANTHONY BARNETT: Larson made a motion, seconded by Dorman and carried to approve the reconciliation change order and final pay estimate of \$2,744.25 to Dave Loden Construction on the town shop roof. Barnett also presented the annual water rights utilization spreadsheet for review.

TOWN ATTORNEY: MIKE MESSENGER: Dorman made a motion, seconded by Larson and carried to proceed with issuing an RFP for garbage collection on a three-year contract, with garbage collection as currently established and with add alternates for (1) individual residential rollouts, (2) monthly large waste pickup and allowing Engineering Associates and Messenger Law Firm to further refine, as necessary.

MAYOR & COUNCIL: Slagle noted the boiler at the water plant was on-line and the filter media project had begun. Lewis noted a grant had been received by the Hot City Outdoor Alliance for an ice-skating rink structure, with an estimated November delivery. The meeting adjourned at 7:19 pm and the next Council meeting is November 2, 2021, at 7pm.
