

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

The Thermopolis Town Council met in regular session November 16, 2021, at 7 pm at Town Hall. Present were Mayor Mike Chimenti, Council members Tony Larson, John Dorman Sr., Bill Malloy and Dusty Lewis. Also, present were Mayor/Codes Administrative Assistant Fred Crosby, Clerk/Treasurer Tracey Van Heule, Interim Police Chief Pat Cornwell, Town Engineer Anthony Barnett and Town Attorneys Mike Messenger and Marshall Keller.

AGENDA: Following the pledge of allegiance, Malloy made a motion, seconded by Dorman and carried to approve the agenda as written.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT: Malloy made a motion, seconded by Dorman and carried to approve the financial statement for October 2021.

CITIZEN PARTICIPATION: Larson made a motion, seconded by Lewis and carried to approve a catering permit for Shorty's on December 4, 2021, for the Ducks Unlimited Banquet at the Fairgrounds. Fair Board permission was received.

ENGINEER: ANTHONY BARNETT: Barnett noted work is progressing on plans for the water line replacement project and tile repair in the water plant filter beds.

TOWN ATTORNEY: MIKE MESSENGER: Nothing at this time.

ADMINISTRATION: FRED CROSBY: Following discussion, the Mayor and Council decided on December 27, 2021 as the extra Christmas holiday.

MAYOR & COUNCIL: Mayor Chimenti noted he would like the employees to receive a \$300 net bonus and funding would come from reducing the health insurance transfer, as the insurance renewal was less than anticipated. Larson made the motion, Malloy seconded and carried. The meeting adjourned at 7:13 pm and the next Council meeting is December 7, 2021, at 7pm.
