

## COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

The Thermopolis Town Council met in regular session March 15, 2022, at 7 pm at Town Hall. Present were Mayor Mike Chimenti, Council members Tony Larson, John Dorman Sr., Bill Malloy and Dusty Lewis. Also, present were Mayor/Codes Administrative Assistant Fred Crosby, Clerk/Treasurer Tracey Van Heule, Public Works Director Ernie Slagle and Town Engineer Anthony Barnette.

AGENDA: Following the pledge of allegiance, Malloy made a motion, seconded by Dorman and carried to approve the agenda as written.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT: Malloy made a motion, seconded by Lewis and carried to approve the financial statement for February 2022.

CITIZEN PARTICIPATION: OEB SALOON: CATERING PERMIT: Malloy made a motion, seconded by Dorman and carried to approve a catering permit to OEB Saloon for the Rocky Mtn Elk Foundation Banquet on April 2, 2022, at the Fair building.

CITIZEN PARTICIPATION: BILL GORDON – HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN: Gordon noted the plan was adopted in 2016 and is reviewed and updated every 5 years. Malloy made a motion, seconded by Larson and carried to approve Resolution 566 – Adopting Wyoming Region 6 Hazard Mitigation Plan.

TOWN ENGINEER: ANTHONY BARNETT: Discussion ensued on a memo from Overfield on the solid waste transfer station. The Town will schedule a meeting with WYDOT on the addition of a turning lane, as part of the WYDOT overlay project on Hwy 20 North. Barnett reviewed a letter from WYDOT on repairing the deck of the Broadway Bridge. WYDOT would be responsible for the planning, designing and construction of the 100% federally financed project. Larson made a motion, seconded by Lewis and carried to notify WYDOT that the Town agrees with the plan to rehabilitate the Broadway bridge.

TOWN ATTORNEY: MICHAEL MESSENGER: Neither Mr. Messenger nor Mr. Keller were in attendance.

ADMINISTRATION: FRED CROSBY: CONSULTANT CONTRACT: Larson made a motion seconded by Dorman and carried to approve the \$6,000 contract with Brad Johnson for health insurance consulting.

ASPHALT RECYCLER BID AWARD: Lewis made a motion, seconded by Malloy and carried to accept the bid from Normont for \$84,695.00 for a KM Int'l T-2 Asphalt Recycler. The singular bid was publicly opened on March 14<sup>th</sup>.

MAYOR & COUNCIL: The meeting adjourned at 7:22 pm and the next Council meeting is April 5, 2022, at 7pm.
