

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

The Thermopolis Town Council met in regular session July 20, 2021, at 7 pm at Town Hall. Present were Mayor Mike Chimenti, Council members Tony Larson, John Dorman Sr., Bill Malloy and Dusty Lewis. Also, present were Mayor/Codes Administrative Assistant Fred Crosby, Clerk/Treasurer Tracey Van Heule, Police Chief Julie Mathews, Town Engineer Anthony Barnett and Town Attorneys Mike Messenger and Marshall Keller.

AGENDA: Following the pledge of allegiance, Larson made a motion, seconded by Malloy and carried to approve the agenda as written.

RESOLUTION 564: BUDGET ADJUSTMENT: Malloy made a motion, seconded by Dorman and carried to approve and adopt Resolution 564, which adjusts the budget to reflect actual costs.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT: Larson made a motion, seconded by Malloy and carried to approve the financial statement for June 2021.

ASSET DELETION: Lewis made a motion, seconded by Malloy and carried to approve the General Fund asset deletion list.

CITIZEN PARTICIPATION: LIQUOR PERMITS: Dorman made a motion, seconded by Larson and carried to approve four catering permits for Shorty's Liquor. Pig Wrestling at the Fairgrounds on August 3 from 5 - 11pm; Discovery Days at the State Park on August 7 & 8th from 9am – 10pm; and the Demo Derby at the Fairgrounds on August 14th from 2pm to midnight. Fair Board permission was received.

ENGINEER: ANTHONY BARNETT: Barnett noted the chip seal pre-bid meeting would be this week, along with the water sanitary survey.

TOWN ATTORNEY: MIKE MESSENGER: Nothing at this time.

ADMINISTRATION: FRED CROSBY: Crosby noted the tires on the landfill scraper were replaced after one blew out, at night. The new landfill cell is being used and landfill well monitoring is continuing this week.

MAYOR & COUNCIL: Malloy updated the Mayor and Council on the recent WAM convention. The next Council meeting is August 3, 2021, at 7pm. The meeting adjourned at 7:30 pm.
