

## COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

The Thermopolis Town Council met in regular session July 21, 2020 at 7 pm at Town Hall. Present were Mayor Mike Chimenti, Council members Tony Larson, John Dorman Sr. and Bill Malloy. Also, present were Mayor/Codes Administrative Assistant Fred Crosby, Clerk/Treasurer Tracey Van Heule, Police Chief Julie Mathews, Town Engineer Anthony Barnett and Town Attorney Mike Messenger. Councilman Dusty Lewis was absent.

AGENDA: Following the pledge of allegiance, Malloy made a motion, seconded by Dorman and carried to approve the agenda with the addition of Danielle Yarrington under Citizen Participation.

RESOLUTION 561: BUDGET ADJUSTMENT: Larson made a motion, seconded by Malloy and carried to approve and adopt Resolution 561, which adjusts the budget to reflect actual costs.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT: Malloy made a motion, seconded by Dorman and carried to approve the financial statement for June 2020.

CITIZEN PARTICIPATION: SHORTY'S: CATERING PERMIT: Larson made a motion, seconded by Dorman and carried to approve a catering permit for Shorty's Liquor for the Demo Derby on August 8, 2020, at the Fairgrounds from 5 pm to 11pm. Fair Board approval was received.

CITIZEN PARTICIPATION: DANIELLE YARRINGTON: Yarrington asked to place tables on 6<sup>th</sup> Street in front of her restaurant (Elle's). Discussion ensued on WYDOT requirements, Town ordinances, number of tables and COVID requirements. Malloy made a motion and Larson seconded to allow 3-4 tables on 6<sup>th</sup> Street, in front of Elle's, if WYDOT and Town requirements were met. In discussion it was noted that no alcohol could be sold outside. Motion carried.

ENGINEER: ANTHONY BARNETT: PROJECT UPDATES: Barnett noted he will survey at the landfill in August.

TOWN ATTORNEY: MIKE MESSENGER: Nothing currently.

ADMINISTRATION: FRED CROSBY: MISC. UPDATES: Malloy made a motion, seconded by Larson and carried to direct Engineering Associates to prepare a RFP for the town shop roof. Crosby will set up a work session before the August 4, 2020 meeting to discuss trash pickup options.

MAYOR & COUNCIL: OTHER: Larson noted he would like to hear from the Golf Course Board concerning conditions at the golf course. Chief Mathews asked about an officer presence at the Demo Derby. The event is being run by an individual instead of the Chamber. Discussion ensued on providing security for a "for-profit" event vs a community event. Larson made a motion, Malloy seconded and carried to approve overtime for two officers.

MAYOR AND COUNCIL: PERSONNEL: HEARING LOGISTICS: EXECUTIVE SESSION: At 7:29 pm, the Mayor and Council went into executive session as allowed under Wyoming statute 16-4-405(a)(ii) for personnel. At 7:42pm, the Mayor and Council returned to the regular meeting and the meeting adjourned. The next Council meeting is August 4, 2020 at 7pm. A work session on trash pickup options will be held at 6pm, before the meeting.
